The Existence of Micro and Small Businesses During the Corona Virus Pandemic (Covid-19) in the City of Makassar

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Abstract:- The purpose of this study was to find out that akhlakul karimah, education or training, expertise or skills, physique, and capital were the factors that made MSEs able to survive during the Corona Virus Pandemic Period in Makassar City. This study uses a qualitative approach, and the main instrument is the researcher himself. The conclusions of this study are 1. Akhlakul Karimah (noble morals), the relation to this during the corona virus pandemic is that during this crisis everyone should strengthen their faith and piety to The One Almighty God. (God Almighty) because these difficult times are a test for those who believe and are pious, while disaster is for those who are unjust. 2. Expertise or Skills. During this corona virus pandemic, everyone is required to be able to survive the ongoing economic crisis. Therefore, expertise or skills should be explored from an early age. At least an expert in managing finances, setting the right strategy in running a business that is in a state of flux. 3. Education or Training. By having knowledge, expertise or skills that can be directed, can be measured, can easily reach the goals of the expertise or skills possessed. 4. Physical. The physique of a human being is synonymous with cleanliness, tidiness, beauty, and strength, so that it will give birth to health in humans. But it all starts with a healthy soul. 5. Capital.

I. INTRODUCTION

During the Corona Virus Pandemic (Covid-19), how many MSMEs died (no longer exist)?, this is one of the captions written in several E-commerce newspapers. Quoted from https://economy.okezone.com/, according to the Ministry of Cooperatives and SMEs, 43% of MSMEs stopped operating due to the corona virus pandemic or Covid-19 in April 2020.

We know that MSME is one of the main pillars of the national economy with an independent perspective, which has great potential to improve the welfare of a nation. According to the researchers, MSMEs are the spearhead and savior of the country's economy because of the potential for MSMEs to make the largest and most significant contribution to the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) in this case employment.

In supporting MSME activities, the government provides support through policies, such as providing injections of funds to MSMEs so that they can run. According to the Central Bureau of Statistics (BPS) in 2009, the number of micro businesses reached 52.2 million or around 98.87%. The existence of MSMEs has made a real contribution to the employment of more than 96.2 million people.

According to Berry et al. (2021) that this MSME group is seen as very important in unstable industries or economies facing rapid changes in market conditions.

The economy in Indonesia nationally shows that MSME activities are consistent and able to develop. The facts show that the job opportunities created by the MSME group are far more than the workforce that can be absorbed by large businesses. Aside from being an alternative way of providing new jobs, MSMEs play a good role in driving the pace of economic growth and as a poverty alleviation program.

Criteria for Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) according to Law. Number 20 of 2008 is classified based on the number of assets and turnover owned by a business. According to sources from the Ministry of Cooperatives and MSMEs in 2013-2015, MSMEs are still the majority actors in the business sector, from 54,114,821 business units in 2013 to 56,534,592 business units in 2015. Meanwhile, the large business sector only has around 3,262,023 workers. in 2015. Makassar City is the capital of South Sulawesi Province, which can be said to have a relatively large number of MSMEs. For more details, it can be seen in Table 1 regarding data on the number of MSMEs per subdistrict in Makassar City.

BPS said that the implementation of the "at home only" work system and online learning system made the communication and information group grow by only 9.79%, but was not enough to withstand the decline that occurred in 13 other business fields categories, such as: retail and wholesale trade, vehicle repair, construction, processing, culinary, even in the service sector, and so on (5 May 2020).

Based on data from the Makassar City Cooperative Service, only a small portion or 6% of the players actually experienced a positive impact, namely more consumers shopping for needs with online transaction patterns which made it easier for MSMEs to find consumers, as well as the products they have more easily accessible to their consumers. . As many as 22% are not affected by this pandemic because some MSMEs sell products that are needed or desired by consumers so that they are not experiencing the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic. As many as 72% (the majority) experienced a negative impact from the co-19 pandemic. There are those whose income has decreased until they can no longer exist in trading. At this time it is clear that because people's activities outside the home as consumers are limited by lockdown rules and PSBB, MSME actors also experience capital difficulties due to very difficult capital turnover associated with declining sales levels. This situation causes MSME actors to adapt. including by reducing the production of goods, as well as reducing the number or working hours of its employees. This impact caused sales of MSME players to experience a decline which affected their income levels. If the level of income decreases absolutely, a prosperous economy in the area cannot be achieved.

Therefore, researchers say the existence of UMK is very important in a prosperous economy. In line with Sri Redjeki Hartono quoted by Derita Prapti Rahayu (2017) regarding the existence of MSMEs. said that the existence of UMKM has a very strategic role for the survival of the community because it

makes a large contribution in meeting the needs of people's lives.

According to Ilham (2020) as Deputy Head of the Astra Honda Motor Branch in Makassar City, he said that during the Corona Virus Pandemic, sales experienced a drastic decline, we even held promos and giveaways and there were very few buyers. This is very dangerous for the sustainability of the company, especially the future fate of the employees. (Live interview, 2020).

According to Daniel Apriyanto (2020), the owner of the Nielqy Shop on Jalan Hertasning, said that his income decreased during the Corona Virus Pandemic, even before the Large-Scale Social Restrictions (PSBB) for his culinary business were closed. After the PSBB was abolished by the Makassar government, Daniel was still afraid and in a dilemma to open his culinary business, coupled with the lack of recovery of personal funds to get up and start again. Even Daniel was forced to lay off three of his employees at once. (Direct interview).

Seeing this phenomenon, not a few Micro and Small Business actors feel the effects of losses, such as: the absence of MSEs. According to the researcher's brief vision, this situation directly changed the MSE actors themselves, as in one example, Daniel said that he was afraid and in a dilemma if he reopened his culinary business during this pandemic.

Talking about the UMK actors themselves, the researcher assumes that the survival of a trading business, the main basis comes from the self-quality of the UMK actors themselves. Researchers assume that there are several crucial things that every MSE actor must instill within themselves so that their business can survive or remain in the Corona Virus Pandemic Period. Crucial things that researchers mean are akhlakul karimah, education, skills, physical, and capital.

The formulation of the problem in this study is whether akhlakul karimah, education or training, expertise or skills, physique, and capital are the factors that make MSEs able to survive during the Corona Virus Pandemic Period in Makassar City.

II. METHODS

This study uses a qualitative approach, and the main instrument is the researcher himself. The number of sub-districts in Makassar City is 15 sub-districts, but it turns out that researchers only found 6 sub-districts where MSEs had operated for more than 3 years in the culinary field, namely: Rappocini District, Ujung Tanah District, Bontoala District, Ujung Pandang District, Panakkukang District, Tamalate, and Tamalanrea District. Activities in data analysis in this study, namely: data reduction, data display, and conclusion drawing/verification.

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III. RESULT

First. Karimah morals. Broadly speaking, Akhlakul Karimah (noble character) has been written in detail, namely: "Virtue is not turning your face east and west, but virtue is people who believe in ALLAH, the last day, angels, books, and the prophets, and give the property he loves to relatives, orphans, the poor, people on the way (travelers), beggars, and to bless my slaves, who perform prayers and pay zakat, people - people who keep their promises when they promise, and people who are patient in poverty, suffering, and in times of war. 


Fig 1. Role Model of Researchers Source: Researcher
